Getting Started

- Unbox your iPad and take off all the packaging
- You wrote your Student ID on your paperwork. Write down the serial number of the iPad under your Student ID
- Place the iPad in the cover
- Turn in your paperwork to your iPad classroom instructor

iPad Care

- Immediately report to office if iPad is lost, stolen, or damaged
- Never leave your iPad unattended
- Avoid extreme temperatures
- iPads do not respond well to liquids
- iPad screen can scratch
- Don't write or put stickers on the iPad

Expectations

- Bring your iPad to class as you would your pen/pencil – it's that important
- Bring your iPad to school fully charged
- Never share information over the Internet about yourself, including name, age, gender, phone number, or where you live
- Modifying settings may result in costs
- Learn – it's a tool, use it to learn

Other Rules

- Video and Photo features
 - Ask permission before recording an individual or group
- No throwing, kicking your iPad or sliding your iPad on a table
- No Swimming with your iPad
- Don't scratch off the serial number – it's there for a reason.
- This will be the iPad that you will use throughout your HS career in Zeeland. Treat it carefully.

Battery Care

- Long term heat or cold is bad
- Adjust Screen Brightness and turn off WiFi when not in use
- Quit apps that you aren't using
- One charge cycle per month (run it dry)

Apps & Other Downloads

- You will begin the year with seven new apps provided by ZPS
- Students may download NON EXPLICIT apps, music, videos, etc... through iTunes
- Purchasing through iTunes will require a credit card
 - ZPS is not responsible for any costs incurred through non-school supplied downloads
- Many apps are free

Misc.

- Any ZPS employee may take your iPad and look at anything on the iPad whenever they wish.
- Clean your iPad with a dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use a “cleaner”, or any kind of alcohol base cleaning cloth. If you must, you can use a slightly damp cloth.
